Digital Citizenship

Guest speaker Mr. Sam Quantz, Director of Technology, presented on technology safety. He said legislature passed a law for citizenship at schools. He also spoke of technology filters and how these filters protect students and staff from inappropriate sites. Mr. Sam Quantz explained that every program could be blocked depending on levels and categories. For example, inappropriate images, videos, and YouTube are blocked for students.

Mr. Quantz said Edison school has about 350 technology devices such as iPads, computers, and laptops. He said they have tools to manage all these devices in one campus. Mr. Quantz also explained the district policy and user policy that outlines acceptable behavior for students and staff. He also emphasized that digital citizenship is more than computer use, it also includes how students interact with each other online, and training is provided for students on how to appropriately communicate. Ms. Zarate went over what happens and how they take care of an incident when students are using technology inappropriately.

Cell Phone Use

Ms. Zarate reviewed the school policy on cell phones. Students are allowed to have a cell phone for emergencies; however, the phone should be in silent mode and out of sight. Students are not allowed to take any pictures or videos of other students. If a student is using a cell phones during school hours, parents will be contacted. Some classrooms have a safe location where students can place their cell phone for the day. Finally, technology devices are not permitted during testing.

School Safety

Ms. Pashell and Ms. Zarate spoke about how parents can safely use the drop off zone. She reminded parents that the left side of the parking is for passing vehicles, and how the crosswalk area needs to be free of cars and always watch for students and parents crossing.
